Minutes of the meeting of the Zion Evangelical Lutheran Church Council held November 12, 2019.

Meeting Called to Order

Following opening devotions by Pastor Andrew Kitzing and discussion on comments regarding the Sabbatical Policy, Julia Johanson called the meeting to order at 7:40 p.m. Lisa Zessin made a motion to approve the agenda. Jackie Strauss seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Approval of Minutes

Minutes from the October 14 Council meeting were distributed. John Borgmann moved to accept the October minutes. Lisa Zessin seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Treasurer's Report

October 2019

John gave the treasurer's report for October to review. Total regular offering for **October 2019** was \$11,275.78 Total expenses were \$10,703.41. Net gain of \$572.37. The checking account balance is \$71,605.47. Special operating funds are \$34,949.98. The year-to-date building fund \$1,715.00. This leaves a spendable balance of \$34,940.49

In early 2019, a CD had matured in the amount of \$11,284.68 and at the March meeting it was voted on to divide the money with \$6,000 going back into a CD and \$5,284.68 going into the parsonage project fund. This has not been done yet. Byron will do research on the best rates for CD's. John adjusted the account balances to include these changes. The adjusted treasurer's report for October was:

Total regular offering for **October 2019** was \$11,275.78 Total expenses were \$10,703.41. Net gain of \$572.37. The checking account balance is \$60,320.79. Special operating funds are \$40,234.66. The year-to-date building fund \$1,715.00. This leaves a spendable balance of \$21,801.13

Byron Nelson made a motion to accept the October 2019 Treasurer's report as amended. LaRita Lang seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Old Business

Columbarium Policy

No update. Byron wants to visit with the cemetery committee to see how a columbarium would fit in the landscape.

Sabbatical Policy

A lot of discussion was held on this topic. Pastor feels that a sabbatical would be good for both himself and for the congregation. There were congregation members upset about the policy who made it known to the Council. Pastor visited with them one on one. It was suggested to possibly document what a typical week or month looks like to make the congregation aware that a sabbatical is very much needed. Pastor will compile a list of what the pastor needs to do before going on a Sabbatical. The Lilly Foundation provides grants for sabbaticals. The grant application deadline for a 2021 sabbatical is April 2020. Some ideas mentioned - pastor would research ideas to better meet the needs of widows and widowers, since we have a growing number in the congregation. There will be a question/answer session after worship on December 8 for the congregation to attend.

New Business

2020 Budget Draft

Julia and Pastor met to draft the proposed 2020 budget. A comment was made that the church roof will need to be replaced in a couple years and the bell tower needs some work done as well. It was suggested that we need to build our contingency fund instead of giving to UNL. However, if each family gave 3% of income, we would be financially sound.

The next Zion Lutheran council meeting will be **Tuesday**, **December 10**, **7:00 PM**.in the Nolte Center.

Being no further business before the Church Council, the meeting was adjourned at 10:18 pm and closed by all joining in praying the Lord's Prayer.
