
Upcoming Events

Zion Lutheran Council held a retreat prior to the meeting. The retreat was held at American Lutheran, 42nd & Vine, Lincoln, NE from 12:30 – 3:30 PM

Meeting Called to Order

Following opening devotions by Pastor Andrew Kitzing, Jackie Strauss called the meeting to order at 3:39 p.m. LaRita Lang made a motion to approve the agenda. Lisa Zessin seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Approval of Minutes

Minutes from the January 14 Council meeting were distributed. Byron Nelson moved to accept the January minutes. John Borgmann seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Pastor's Report

January 26 – was the Annual meeting following worship then a potluck lunch. February 4 – Attended Brooks Institute – good meeting with several denominations represented February 6 – Lutheran Prayer Breakfast – clergy and bishop attended. February 11 – Cemetery committee meeting – make sure map/reserved plots are up to date February 16 – Baptism and Maddie and Jacob Terjl's send off February 20 – Justice Committee meeting February 26 – Ash Wednesday with soup supper 5:30-6:30

Treasurer's Report

John handed out the treasurer's report to review. Total regular offering for **January 2020** was \$14,042.33. Total expenses were \$9,927.61. Net gain of \$4,114.72. The asset account balance is \$97,369.16. Special operating funds are \$49,010.04. The year-to-date building fund \$115.00. This leaves a spendable balance of \$48,244.12. Parsonage Improvement Fund" - \$-34,368.80 John added a new line in the balance sheet *- "Parsonage Improvement Fund"* and said that \$2,000 that came was specifically earmarked for the parsonage fund. He also updated the CD and Bonds to reflect the face value amount. LaRita Lang made a motion to approve the treasurer's report. Jackie Strauss seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Ministry Reports

Education Ministry: Children will sing on February 16. Maddie Terjl will be leaving, so a teacher will be

needed. Jackie commented that they attended 4 different churches on their vacation and all of these churches had Low Sunday School attendance.

Property Ministry: Will be meeting in the next few weeks.

Social Ministry: Supper will be held prior to each Wednesday Lenten service.

<u>Evangelism Ministry</u>: Pastor will meet with Randy to begin preparation for the "Field Meal Project". It will begin with this spring planting season – so could be 3^{rd} or 4^{th} week in April.

Stewardship Ministry: No report.

2019 Annual Meeting Review.

Pastor handed out copies of Zion's Constitution, Bylaws and Resolutions. Copies will be available for review in the Nolte Center and on the Zion website. LaRita will note this in the newsletter.

Columbarium – No update.

Sabbatical – Pastor handed out a proposal for Council to review. The proposal – take 4 weeks in 2020 and 6 weeks in 2021. For 2020, he plans to go on sabbatical July 27 – August 29, 2020. A forum with the congregation will be held in a few weeks.

The next Zion Lutheran council meeting will be on March 10, 2020.

Being no further business before the Church Council, the meeting was adjourned at 5:20 pm and closed by all joining in praying the Lord's Prayer.
